

## QUINCY TOUR 1

**10:00 a.m.** Golden, IL, Prairie Mills Windmill and "R" Pizza Farm

Begin with tour of Prairie Mill Windmill, a smock mill built in 1892, with its original stones, gears, etc. still in place. Located at 902 Prairie Mills Road. (217-696-2722) While half of the group is touring the Windmill, the other half can tour the "R" Pizza Farm at the Ocean Farm. This 150ft circular pizza farm shows visitors the process of growing ingredients for an entire pizza. (217-696-2493)

**11:30 a.m.** Tour of Quincy's East End Historic District and historic Maine Street to view some of the most significant architecture outside of Chicago.

**12:00 p.m.** Lunch at Tiramisu Italian Restaurant, at 137 North 3rd St. A lunch menu provided. 217.222.9560

**1:30 p.m.** Arrive at Villa Kathrine for a tour of our visitor's center, our own Mediterranean castle overlooking the Mississippi River.

**2:30 p.m.** Tour of the Quincy Museum, at 1601 Maine St. This spectacular museum located in Quincy's East End Historic District is on the National Register of Historic Places.

**3:30 p.m.** Drive through Quincy's historic German district. Many of the homes in Calftown have been restored; see the old German school, drive by Dick Brother's Brewery, once larger than Anheuser-Busch in St. Louis.

**5:00 p.m.** Dinner at The Patio Restaurant, 133 South 4th Street (217-222-6065)

**7:00 p.m.** Drive down to Clat Adams Park along the Riverfront for a sunset viewing.

**9:30 a.m.** Visit the Jesus Tree, at Calvary Cemetery, 1730 North 18th Street

**10:00 a.m.** Visit the IL. Veterans' Home, the largest and oldest Veteran Home in Illinois, 1707 North 12th St.

**10:15 a.m.** The All Wars Museum, located at the entrance of the Veterans' Home.

**11:00 a.m.** Tour the Dr. Richard Eells House, 415 Jersey. The oldest standing two-story home in Quincy was once a stopping point on the Underground Railroad.

**12:00 Noon** Lunch at the Pier Restaurant, 401 Bayview Drive (Riverfront), 217.221.0020

**1:15 p.m.** Visit the Quincy Museum, at 1601 Maine St. (217-224-7669)

**2:30 p.m.** Tour the Gardner Museum of Architecture and Design, 332 Maine St. (217-224-6873)

**3:30 p.m.** Light bite at TCBY Yogurt, 18th & State St. (217- 228-2292)
